SGA-Judicial is one of three branches of the Student Government Association designed to provide an outlet for the student voice at UNC Charlotte.



Our Role

Advised through the Office of Student Conduct in the Dean of Students Office, the SGA-Judicial Branch, or Student Court, is a body of students approved by the SGA Senate to enforce, investigate, and adjudicate alleged violations of UNC Charlotte's *Code of Student Responsibility* which is in place to protect the University community and to maintain an environment conducive to learning.

Student Court members are also entrusted with the responsibility of guaranteeing student rights in the conduct process, promoting fairness through peer adjudication, and assisting in the education of the University community with regard to conduct rules and regulations.

In addition, Student Court hopes to help foster the personal and social development of those student who are held accountable for violations of University regulations.

SCOOP

Student Court Orientation & Outreach Programs are educational presentations designed to actively inform the University community about student rights and responsibilities, academic and behavioral policies, the student conduct process, and the potential consequences for violating University policies.

SCOOP presentations are intended to help the University community understand student rights and responsibilities at UNC Charlotte. While you choose the main topic of the presentation, SCOOP can be tailored to fit your concerns, needs, and availability.

Our presenters are members of Student Court who have been carefully selected and trained to educate the University community. They are dedicated to the belief that the student conduct process can play a vital role in the personal and educational development of the UNC Charlotte community and its students.
